**KBGA ensured that a good representation of their members visit the families of the 2 diseased people at Mel-Cowatty village and shared the grief of the families much to the solace of the families and the Village people. KBGA has disbursed Rs. 25000 ( Twenty five thousand) to each of the 2 families and consoled them to gain courage to go on.**
